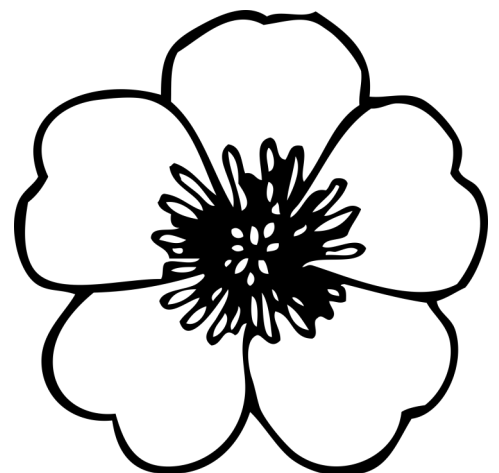
Bring a lawn chair and a dish to pass. After worship we will enjoy lunch together. Come, enjoy the outdoors
