Dear Members of St. James,

It is Holy Week! Sometimes we say that we will have multiple services this week but the truth is that we will have only one service that will last three days! Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter should really be thought of as ONE service where we gather to celebrate the central mystery of our faith – the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ! Until, perhaps, the 1960's the highest attended service among Lutherans was not Easter, as we might expect, but Good Friday. On Good Friday we contemplate the magnitude of God's love that God would empty himself, as St. Paul says in Philippians, "taking the form of a slave, being born in human likeness. And being found in human form, he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death-- even death on a cross." Do no miss these opportunities to celebrate the depth of our faith this Holy Week. We begin Holy Week with the celebration of Palm/Passion Sunday. We will begin in the front of the church, weather permitting, and process with palms into the sanctuary where we will hear the Passion of our Lord read with congregational members reading various parts. 


CHURCH OFFICE NOTES
