HOLY COMMUNION

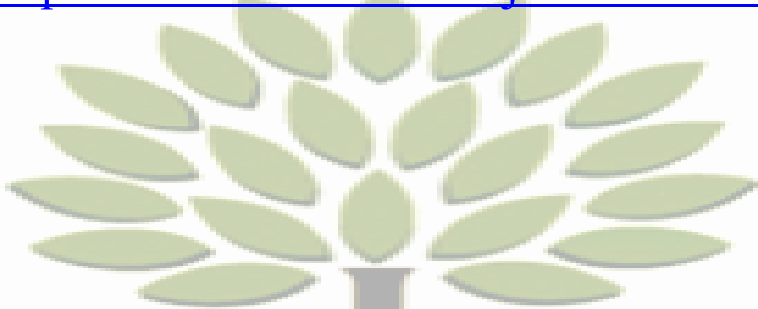

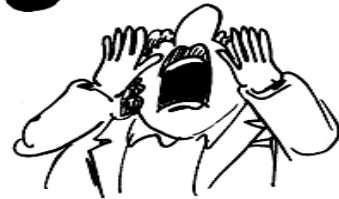
