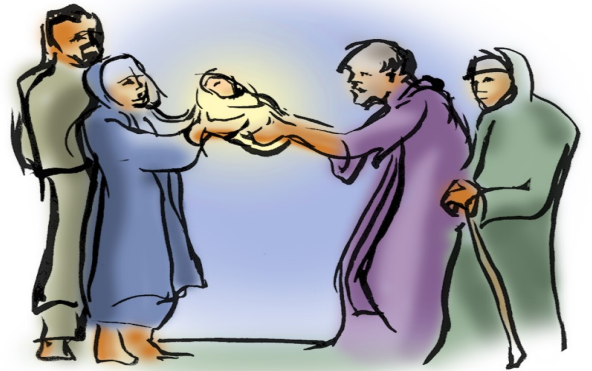


ST. JAMES LUTHERAN MESSENGER
