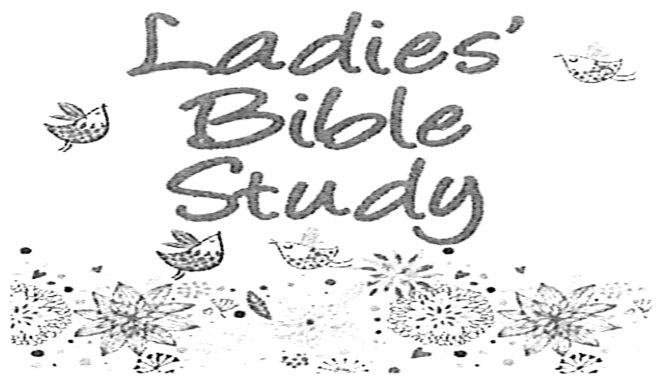

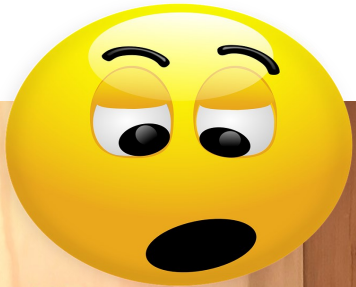

# FOOD BANK



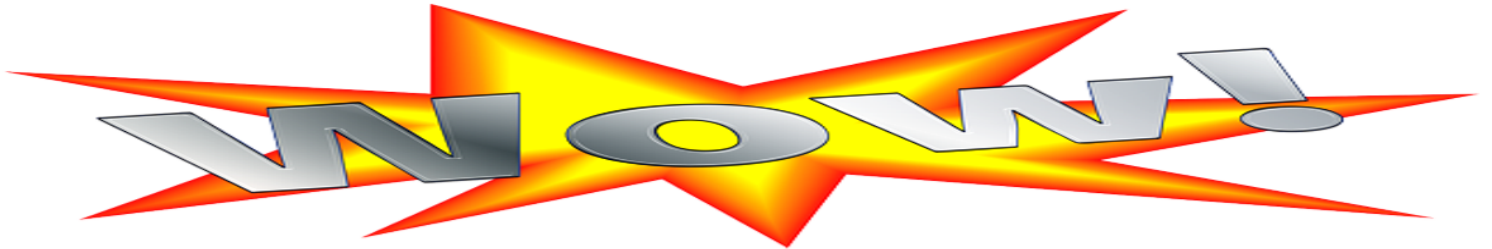
